**Spina Car Wash** – City Attorney Dale Coffey explained a problem with the Poston Road Stormwater Project and Spina's Car Wash. The exit drive from the car wash was not part of the bid to repair during this project. Spina's were told by contractor of the project, Milestone. Mr. Coffey believes the City should be responsible in restoring the exit drive. No one can explain why it wasn't included in the original project. A bid from Wallace Construction in the amount of \$9,800.00 was presented to the Board of Works for consideration. A motion to accept and approve the bid was made by Boardmember Terry Buster and seconded by Boardmember Eric Bowlen. The Motion passes 3-0.

**Patty Hicks** - DPW Frank Lane reported a problem with standing water in the area of West Harrison Street just off Park Avenue. The Hicks resident is at the same area. A drywell has been covered over and that is the reason of the standing water. Scott Manley appeared and said there is a storm sewer in the area. After a discussion, Boardmember Eric Bowlen made a motion to pursue the best remedy and that repairs be paid from the Storm Water Fund. Boardmember Terry Buster seconded the motion. Water Operations Assistant Manager Scotty Manley announced the cleaning of Well #3 is complete and has passed numerous water tests.

John Marvel, 492 Valley Drive appeared. He stated he owns rental property in the Poston Road / Marilyn Street area. Mr. Marvel received a water/sewer bill over \$3,000.00. His grounds keeper discovered a pipe broken in pieces near the meter of his property where water was ponding. Milestone, contractor for the Poston Road Storm Sewer Project, had dug out the area then filled in the area with gravel. Mr. Marvel had received a sewer adjustment but felt he should also receive a water credit as this was possibly caused by Milestone. Boardmember Eric Bowlen suggested the matter be tabled until Ross Holloway could be present to discuss his findings.

Grady Brothers will begin paving East Morgan Street this Thursday.

City Attorney Dale Coffey asked that action on 72 Lincoln Heights be tabled until June 6, 2016.
